TITLE: First Things First, Home Visitation Grant Approval

## **BACKGROUND:**

The statewide First Things First (FTF) North Pima County Home Visitation Grant (FTF-MULTI-16-0559-00) could be awarded to the Amphi Parents As Teachers Program in order to continue providing early childhood education opportunities to the families and children who reside in our district for the Fiscal Year 2016 with Board approval.

Parents and families play a pivotal role in shaping their child's lives and preparing them for success in school. Most children spend the first three to four years of their lives primarily interacting with their parents, siblings and other family members.

The purpose of the First Things First Grant and the Home Visitation Program is to provide a mechanism by which families can enhance their knowledge and skills on how to best support their child's optimal development. Over the past twelve years, *Amphi Parents As Teachers* has partnered with families to deliver comprehensive, evidence based home visits which provide participating families with children under five, information and education on parenting, child development and health topics while assisting with connection to other resources or programs as needed to prepare their children for kindergarten. All families within the district boundaries may participate regardless of financial need; families outside our boundaries or beyond our caseload capabilities are referred to other Pima county participants of the grant.
