Project Name	Description
<b>Vestavia City Schools</b> Vestavia, AL	3 year project, expected to end in 2019 providing preconstruction and project management services. \$60+ million, 8 school project. HPM reduced overall cost of proposed bond program by 5%, increasing the number of facilities improved within the system
<b>The University of Alabama</b> Tuscaloosa, AL	\$200 million annual capital expenditure program including: Educational facilities, Athletic facilities, Parking decks, Residence halls, Utilities and infrastructure
<b>Homewood City Schools</b> Homewood, AL	2 year program, expected to end in 2019. \$55,000,000 upgrade and renovation project involving 3 elementary schools, a middle school and a high school
