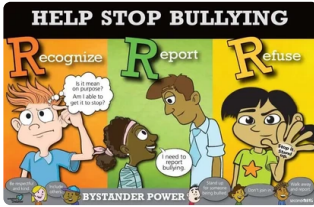

Greetings!

March was all about bully prevention. Students learned to recognize, refuse and report bullying. The intermediate students also learned about what it means to be a 'bystander' to bullying and the power that comes with being a 'bystander.' It is important for students to know the

difference between bullying, and a mean moment or a conflict with another student. Bullying is taken very seriously and all students need to learn to recognize the signs.

April and May marks the time of state testing for 3rd - 5th graders. Please ensure that you students are getting lots of rest, eating well and drinking lots of water. This season of testing can be stressful for some kids. I encourage you to stick to your typical family routines around mealtime and bedtime to reduce any added disruption.. Additionally, incorporating some mindful activities, outdoor walks, or whatever is a favorite activity for your family to help alleviate the possible stress and to create an opportunity for conversations about how to cope with whatever worries might be bubbling up.

Measles: It's not just a little rash

- Measles is a very contagious, viral disease.
- Measles can be dangerous, especially for babies and young children.
- About 20-40% of people with measles will need to be hospitalized.
- One in every three will suffer complications such as ear infection or lung infection. In rare cases, it can lead to inflammation of the brain, which can cause long-term effects.
- For every 1,000 children with measles, one to two will die from it.

Measles symptoms

- Fever
- Cough and runny nose
- Red eyes
- A red rash that generally appears 3-5 days after other symptoms. It starts on the head and face and spreads to the rest of the body.
- Symptoms usually develop within one to two weeks after being exposed to someone with measles. Rarely, it can take up to four weeks for symptoms to appear.

How measles spreads

- Measles spreads when someone sick with the virus coughs or sneezes. It can also be spread by direct contact with nose or throat mucus of someone with measles.
- People can spread measles before they show obvious symptoms.
- A person who has never had a measles vaccine or a case of measles will almost always catch the disease if they are near an infected person.
- People are contagious with measles for four days before the rash appears and up to four days after.

Always call first

If you suspect you or your child has measles, please call your provider or an urgent care clinic first to make arrangements to avoid spreading the virus to others. Tillamook County Community Health Center and Nehalem Bay Health Center will make arrangements to see

patients in their vehicle or a separate space if the patient has no vehicle. Adventist Health Primary Care, Urgent Care, and ER will provide you with instructions when you call.

You are protected from measles if:

- You are under age four and have had one dose of the measles, mumps and rubella vaccine.
- You are four or older and have had two measles vaccines.
- You were born before 1957.
- You have a blood test that shows you are immune.

Protect yourself and your family

The first dose of measles vaccine should be given at 12 to 15 months of age. The second dose at age 4 to 6. But it's never too late to get vaccinated. If you or your child have missed a vaccine, talk to your doctor about catching up.

The measles vaccine is safe and effective

- The measles, mumps and rubella vaccine is very safe and has been used since the 1970s.
- It is highly effective at making sure you don't get measles at all.
- Minor side effects might occur and include pain at the site, fever, a mild rash and minor swelling.
- Severe side effects and allergies are very rare.
- No mercury is in childhood vaccines.

Sarampión: no es solo un simple sarpullido

- El sarampión es una enfermedad viral muy contagiosa.
- El sarampión puede ser peligroso, sobre todo para los bebés y los niños pequeños.
- Alrededor del 20-40% de las personas con sarampión deberán ser hospitalizadas.
- Uno de cada tres sufrirá complicaciones como infección de oído o pulmón. En raras ocasiones, puede provocar inflamación del cerebro, lo que puede causar efectos a largo plazo.
- De cada 1,000 niños con sarampión, entre uno y dos pueden morir.

Síntomas del sarampión

- Fiebre
- Tos y secreción nasal
- Ojos rojos
- Una erupción roja que suele aparecer entre 3 y 5 días después de otros síntomas. Comienza en la cabeza y la cara y se extiende al resto del cuerpo.
- Los síntomas suelen aparecer una o dos semanas después de haber estado expuesto a alguien con sarampión. En raras ocasiones, los síntomas pueden tardar hasta cuatro semanas en aparecer.

Cómo se contagia el sarampión

- El sarampión se contagia cuando una persona enferma tose o estornuda. También puede contagiarse por contacto directo con la mucosidad de la nariz o la garganta de alguien que padece de sarampión.
- Las personas pueden contagiarse de sarampión antes de mostrar síntomas evidentes.

- Una persona que nunca se haya vacunado contra el sarampión ni haya tenido un caso de sarampión casi siempre contraerá la enfermedad si está cerca de una persona infectada.
- El sarampión es contagioso cuatro días antes de que aparezca la erupción y hasta cuatro días después.

Llamar antes siempre

Si sospecha que usted o su hijo tienen sarampión, llame primero a su proveedor de servicios de salud o a una clínica de atención urgente para tomar las medidas necesarias para evitar contagiar el virus a otras personas.

Estará protegido contra el sarampión si

- Tiene menos de cuatro años y ha recibido una dosis de la vacuna contra el sarampión, las paperas y la rubéola.
- Tiene cuatro años o más y ha recibido dos vacunas contra el sarampión.
- Nació antes de 1957.
- Tiene un análisis de sangre que demuestra que es inmune.

Protéjase y proteja a su familia

La primera dosis de la vacuna contra el sarampión debe administrarse entre los 12 y los 15 meses de edad. La segunda dosis entre los 4 y los 6 años. Pero nunca es demasiado tarde para vacunarse. Si usted o su hijo o hija se han saltado alguna vacuna, hable con su médico para ponerse al día.

- Con su proveedor de servicios médicos.
- En algunas farmacias.

La vacuna contra el sarampión es segura y eficaz

- La vacuna contra el sarampión, las paperas y la rubéola es muy segura y se utiliza desde los años setenta.
- Es muy eficaz para evitar el sarampión.
- Pueden aparecer efectos secundarios leves, como dolor en la zona de aplicación, fiebre, erupción cutánea leve e hinchazón leve.
- Los efectos secundarios graves y las alergias son muy poco frecuentes.
- Las vacunas infantiles no contienen mercurio.
