Suggested Motion: Move to approve the presented BP 0410 Nondiscrimination in District Programs and Activities as presented.

Optional Amendment to the Motion for Board Consideration: Move to amend BP 0410 Nondiscrimination in District Programs and Activities to include the following language as Paragraph 2:

Craig Public School District employees may not direct or otherwise compel a student to personally affirm, adopt, or adhere to, or provide a course of instruction or unit of study that directs or otherwise compels a student to affirm, adopt, or adhere to, the following tenets:

- a given sex, race, ethnicity, religion, color, or national origin is inherently superior or inferior;
- an individual should be treated adversely based on the individual's sex, race, ethnicity, religion, color, or national origin; and
- an individual, by virtue of the individual's sex, race, ethnicity, religion, color, or national origin, is inherently responsible for actions committed in the past by other members of the same sex, race, ethnicity, religion, color, or national origin.
