BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- During the 2020-2021 school year, AISD will work continue to focus efforts on building capacity as a Professional Learning Community (PLC) through engaging in PLC actions at each campus.
- The three big ideas that drive the work of the PLC process include:
 - Learning as our Fundamental Purpose
 - Building a Collaborative Culture Through High-Performing Teams
 - A Focus on Results
- At the campus and district level, PLC actions will be monitored and rated at the end of each grading cycle on an implementation continuum that corresponds to the three big ideas of a PLC.
- Data will be collected and analyzed in order to assess team and district level implementation of the three big ideas throughout the school year.
- The district-wide PLC goal related to a Focus on Results is:
 - By June 2021, 93% of the Aledo ISD collaborative teams district-wide will rate at the "Developing" level or higher on the PLC at Work at Continuum. This indicator on the PLC continuum states that collaborative teams will establish annual SMART goals and will assess progress toward reaching the goal.
- Collaborative teams across the district have established SMART goals for the 2020-2021 school year that support the district mission and vision.
- Two collaborative teams (Walsh, 2nd Grade and AHS, English II) will share their team SMART goals with the Board of Trustees and will discuss their process for establishing the goal and monitoring progress toward the goal.
