HSA ENROLLMENT:

The current HSA enrollment is 39 students. In April, <u>22</u> students are on track to graduate from the center. There are at least 40+ students on the waiting list. Of the current enrollment, twenty students are EOC complete and seventeen students are IGC eligible.

- HSA will host a job and career fair in May. Walker County Businesses, Workforce Solutions and local technical schools will come out and work with students on interview skills, dressing for success and have the opportunity to apply for jobs in HSA. The event is open to HSA current and previous students.

 During the months of February and March, each branch will continue to visit with HSA students who are interested in enlisting in the military.




