EdCaliber Learning System Implemented in Morrow County School District:

What is EdCaliber?

It is an Instructional Improvement System (IIS) that offers educators the opportunity to collaborate, find resources, plan lessons and track Common Core and state standards. Teachers can use EdCaliber resources for supplemental curriculum, stand-alone curriculum and professional development.

What is EngageNY?

EngageNY is an open source curriculum that was created to assist schools and districts with the implementation of the Common Core, The New York State Education Department (NYSED) has provided free curriculum modules that can be adopted or adapted for local purposes. NYSED has invested \$26 million in the development of the EngageNY curriculum, which is fully aligned to the Common Core State Standards (CCSS). Each lesson has been carefully vetted to ensure its rigor, level of complexity, and accuracy.

How can EdCaliber Help MCSD?

It can work as a supplemental curriculum transition for mathematics. We will not adopt updated Common Core aligned math curriculum for at least the next 3 years. It is essential for our teachers to have information for all CCSS standards. EngageNY has enough CCSS curriculum content by grade level and subject area to work as a stand-alone curriculum.
