Amphitheater School District COURSE REQUEST FORM

I. RATIONALE – justification of need, citing data

The JTED Central course is for Amphitheater students who are enrolled in the Pima County JTED's Cosmetology, Certified Nursing Services, and Fire Services programs. Students from Amphitheater, Canyon Del Oro, and Ironwood Ridge High Schools participate in these Pima County JTED Central Programs at JTED central sites. Students in these programs have intense workloads which they complete during afternoon, evening and weekend classes. Because of the time constraints of these programs, some Amphitheater students have difficulty maintaining a four course workload at their home high school. This impacts the student's Amphitheater Average Daily Membership (ADM). Developing the JTED Central course, where attendance is taken at our high schools, will enable the Amphitheater School District to generate .25 ADM towards the student's full-time ADM. The JTED Central course will only be available for seniors who are on track to graduate.

- **II. DESCRIPTION course goals and objectives, pre-requisites, format** We are seeking approval only for the addition of the JTED Central course for ADM purposes. The Cosmotology, Certified Nursing and Fire Services programs are already Amphitheater Governing Board approved.

- **IV. AUDIENCE student group (school, grade, discipline) to be served** Seniors will be served by this JTED Central course.
- V. **RESOURCES specific texts, materials, equipment needed** There is no cost to the district for the JTED Central course because the programs are taught at Pima County JTED sites. No Amphitheater Public Schools resources or materials will be used.

VI. OUTCOME – evaluation of course effectiveness

The Executive Director of Secondary Education, Career and Technical Education Director, High School administration and counselors will evaluate on an annual basis the effectiveness of the JTED Central course for its benefit to Amphi students and district.
