It is already hard enough to get everything done in a day( chores, homework, diner, social izing, family obligations, rest) without trying to cram in a longer day of school, packed with more work.

We think the four day week would be good for students, teachers and families. We have not heard any negative comments about the four day week from other districts that are on a four day week.

my only concern is finding child care in the area on the off day.

It would be beneficial for parents to have anecdotal information about the pros and cons of the 4 day week. Reports from other districts who run a 4 day week should be provided for those wanting the information. If this would truly save our district money, than we are all for it.

It would fit our family due to our business is very busy during the weekends and my kids have to miss Fridays most of the time

also to save money k kids go all day then you dont have bus route passing each other in mid day. i work here in homedale and go home for lunch and see buses all over.

I feel like we have enough children that are left unsupervised, and are constantly in trouble, or would be. Most parents would result in their children k-4 at home with another sibling, or possibly home alone. I think that children also getting up that much earlier. some kids get on the bus or ready for the bus at 7, so you take a 7 or 8 year old and make them get up at 530 or so to have enough time to get ont he bus at what 6? I think in the younger age groups its a horrible Idea. In High school, yes with academics, and sports I feel like a 4 day work week is much more beneficial, but not for kids in k-8.

We both work Fridays

We are looking forward to the 4 day week.

This would be beneficial due to the expense and budget concerns for the district. In that I agree. The additional expense for childcare would be the main concern.

I think the kids would be way too tired during the week since practices, games, and other events would still occuring during the week. Teachers will have to put up with those tired kids. I am also concerned that children who don't have a parent at home during the day. Would they just be home alone, with an opportunity to get into trouble.

I feel additional instructional time per day would not be as efficient as in a five day week. Children's attention spans especially at younger ages are short and I feel that is too much time each day to be in the classroom.

I believe it will not only negatively effect my children, but all of the children in the district. My children do not participate in the Free/Reduced lunch program, but the children that do will possibly not receive nutrition. This alone, is one strong reason I do not advocate for a four day school week. Proper nutrition is key to brain develoment and effects one's ability to learn. In additon to this concern, there are many children, my son included, who struggle to sit in a desk and be in a classroom setting for six hours a day. I believe adding an hour to the school day will not benefit these children, and actually create more difficulty for the students and their teachers. I think it would be unconscionable for our school district to only look at the bottom dollar and not consider the responsibility we have to provide quality education and a safe environment for children in our community.

One of my main concerns regarding a change to 4 days would be the impact on kids in sports. Early morning practices are already terribly early and the 5/6th grade kids are already having practices between 7-8:30 pm. in addition to the limited space in the wrestling room means that practices have to be stacked and often run late into the evening; especially for younger kids.
