Professional Development – RRR Conference

I, along with other HISD Administrators, have been attending the RRR Conference this past week. This conference is one of the best conferences in the state of Texas. I have attended a variety of sessions but a few note-worthy sessions were:

‘What If’ – this session provided resources and tools to access unrealized potential in teachers and students. As well as tips to stop managing change – but to create positive change in our schools.

‘Calling All School Leaders’ – this session focused on topics associated with increasing positive school culture, relevant strategies to boost cognition, and the achievement game.

‘Lifting Student Voices’ – this session dealt with shifting the focus from teacher-centered feedback to student-centered learning objectives. Discuss the possibilities of using peer review and student-centered feedback in the classroom on a daily basis.
