Formal observations

Unscheduled for a minimum of 45 minutes

Teacher self-reflection

Completed by teacher to bring to post-conference

summary

Post-conference summary

Within 10 working day of observation

Second appraisal

A teacher may request within 10 working days after receiving a post-conference summary or end-of-year conference summary with which he/she disagrees

Informal observations including coaching summary

April 5, 2021

(Conduct and submit written evidence for at least two documented informal observations for every classroom teacher with coaching summary)

Intervention plans

At the discretion of appraiser when rating is "Emergent"

End-of-Year Conferences (Including Preliminary Teacher Goal Setting & Professional Development Plans) May 17, 2021

Consult with HR/Superintendent Regarding

By January 25, 2021

Individuals with tenuous status

Current Technology:

Current Technology Needs:

- Teacher laptops to adequately deliver online instruction
- Swivel Cameras
- Adaptors for the teacher Dell Laptops
- Adaptors for tablet wall chargers
- Cases for tablets ordered
- Additional student laptops, tablets, and chromebooks
- 600 MIFIs



Operation Connectivity:

- Initiative founded by Texas Education Agency (TEA) in collaboration with Governor Abbott and Dallas ISD
- Operational Connectivity matches funding for bulk orders
- Serves as reimbursement program for purchases made on or after May 21-July 22, 2020
- Connect All Texas K-12 students with reliable internet and devices by 2022

- 1130 Laptops for the Secondary level
- 275 Chromebooks for Elementary Level
- 350 MIFIs
