Background Information:

- The purpose of this agreement is to provide students with an opportunity to earn both college and high school credit while enrolled in high school.
- The dual enrollment agreement will consist of core subject courses as well as CTE courses.

Administrative Considerations:

- Teachers are required to participate in a three-day professional learning program at Tarleton State University, Fort Worth Campus in July, as well as one virtual professional learning program each semester.
- This program does not require a TSI score, allowing more Keller ISD students to earn college credit while in high school.
