RECOMMENDATION:

The Texas Education Agency offers school districts the opportunity to offer a program that will offer flexible hours and days of attendance for a student who:

- Has dropped out of school;
- Is at risk of dropping out, or
- Will be denied credit for one or more classes in which the student has been enrolled as a result of attendance requirements under the Texas Education Code §25.092

In an effort to continue assisting with the reduction of the dropout rate and increase students' attendance rates at Lyndon B. Johnson High School, Administration proposes to continue the PASS Program. The PASS Program is an intervention for students who are at-risk of not graduating due to loss of credit. Lyndon B. Johnson will use various district resources, which provide campus administration a solution to address these concerns.
