Contract

DISCUSSION: At its meeting on January 23, 2018, the Board of Trustees

authorized the District President or his designee to monitor pricing offered by Retail Electric Providers and execute an electricity supply contract as deemed in the best interest of

the District.

The District's contracted energy consultant, Energy Edge, received pricing proposals from the Texas General Land Office ("GLO"), MP2, MidAmerican and TXU. The GLO provided the best value to the District with a rate of

\$0.03884 per kWh for each kilowatt-hour of electricity. The electricity supply Retail Sales Agreement was executed on

March 7, 2018 with the GLO. The contracted rate is effective May 1, 2019 through April 30, 2022. The

estimated cost savings over the current rate for the three

year term is \$106,107.00.
