
Parent-Teacher Conferences

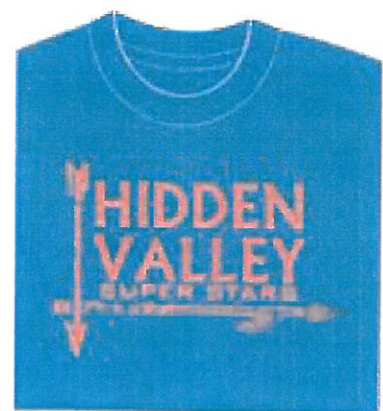
