It is oriented to motivate parents and educators to work together and develop social emotional skills to have healthier relationships in the future.



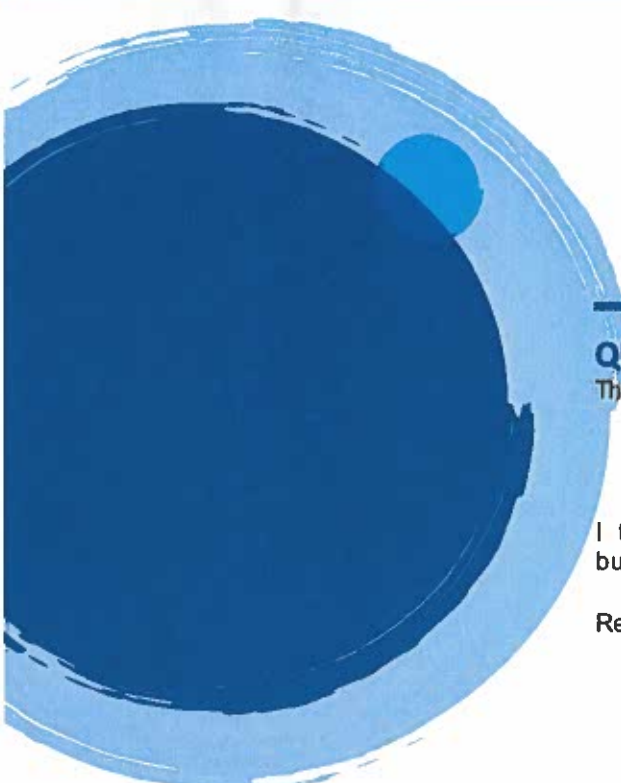

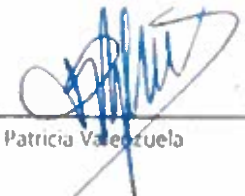
