SUBJ: **Proposed ASBA Bylaw Changes Notice**

Article VIII Section 1.(b) allows for changes to the ASBA Bylaws to be brought forward "by action of a member board, the Board of Directors of this Association, or any committee appointed by it...and shall be transmitted to the executive director not later than sixty (60) days prior to the date of the annual membership meeting." It goes on to say that "Such amendments shall be forwarded to the membership at least thirty (30) days prior to the annual membership meeting."

As Interim Executive Director, I certify that I have received recommended changes to the ASBA Bylaws brought forward by resolution of the ASBA Board of Directors. BYLAW CHANGE NOTICE

(NEW LANGUAGE IN CAPITALS)

Current language:

ARTICLE V Officers and Board of Directors and Executive Committee.

Section 3. Qualifications

Each officer and director, with the exception of the immediate past president, shall be a member of a governing board which is a member of the Association. No more than one elected officer shall be elected from any one member board.

Proposed change:

ARTICLE V Officers and Board of Directors and Executive Committee.

Section 3. Qualifications

Each officer and director, with the exception of the immediate past president, shall be a member of a governing board which is a member of the Association. No more than one elected officer shall be elected from any one member board AND NO TWO (2) BOARD OF DIRECTORS' POSITIONS MAY BE HELD BY THE SAME PERSON.

SPECIAL NOTICE

IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE IV. SECTION 2(A) OF THE ASSOCIATION BYLAWS, A GOVERNING BOARD THAT IS AN ACTIVE MEMBER OF THE ASSOCIATION SHALL BE DEEMED TO BE PRESENT AT A MEMBERSHIP MEETING IF ONE OR MORE MEMBERS OF SUCH GOVERNING BOARD ARE IN ATTENDANCE. ON EACH MATTER PRESENTED TO THE MEMBERSHIP FOR VOTE, EACH GOVERNING BOARD THAT IS AN ACTIVE MEMBER SHALL BE ENTITLED TO ONE VOTE, PROVIDED SUCH GOVERNING BOARD OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT HAS PAID DUES AS ESTABLISHED AND ASSESSED AS IN SECTION 3(A) HEREAFTER. THE RIGHT TO THE FLOOR FOR THE PURPOSE OF DISCUSSION SHALL, HOWEVER, BE OPEN TO ANY AND ALL MEMBERS OF A GOVERNING BOARD THAT IS AN ACTIVE MEMBER.
