Three bids were opened on Monday, September 17, 2007 at 9:00 A.M. by Nancy McReynolds, Karen Walker and Kenneth Roberts. Terry Caples of Truck Center, and Mark Moore of Interactive Video Solution – Angel Trax Systems attended the bid opening. The low bid for single cameras and recording systems for forty buses was submitted by Truck Center offering the SEON Design Inc. TR1-BD Trooper Single Channel Basic Mobile Video Monitoring System. The amount above is for a turnkey bid with installation and one year of maintenance in addition to the equipment.

IVS Angel Trax Systems offered three bids for three systems and ZEPSCO Sales offered a bid. See bid offers below:

Due to the budget allowance of \$50,000, the district requests that the Board award this bid in the amount of \$52,235.00 to install cameras in 33 buses, two handheld units, and main system at Transportation Office.
