Local School Committee Minutes for September 13, 2011 Greenway Elementary

Committee Members - Tamara Lindsay and Darrell McGee

- 1. Enrollment Update: Enrollment at Greenway is up by approximately 50 students. Kindergarten and first grade class sizes average 25 students. Second and third grade have class sizes of approximately 28 students. Fourth grade averages 26 students and each fifth grade class has 33 students.
- 2. Local Option Levy—Bob provided the committee a November 8, Local Option Level fact sheet along with tax calculator.
- 3. Building Use Permits- The committee reviewed and approved six building use permits.
