

## D12 Cases 2021-22

### August-December

- RMS: 24 positive cases
- Close Contacts Requiring Quarantine RMS: 48
- SHS: 38 positive cases
- Close Contacts Requiring Quarantine SHS: 70
- 2 grade levels placed in adaptive pause (September, December)

### January

- RMS: 19 positive cases
- Close Contacts Requiring Quarantine RMS: 17
- Current Test to Stay RMS: 2
- SHS: 22 positive cases
- Close Contacts Requiring Quarantine SHS: 32
- Current Test to Stay SHS: 6

**Attendance: Thirty-three (5%) of students have missed more than 20% of school days. (definition of chronic absenteeism is greater than 10% of school days)**



## Testing

- 103 tests conducted last week (90 on Thursday with Northshore Lab staff, 23 by health office staff)
- Families who may want symptomatic or test to stay are encouraged to sign up now so as not to experience a delay when needed
- Shifting from cheek swab testing to shallow nasal swab (learned of change this afternoon)
