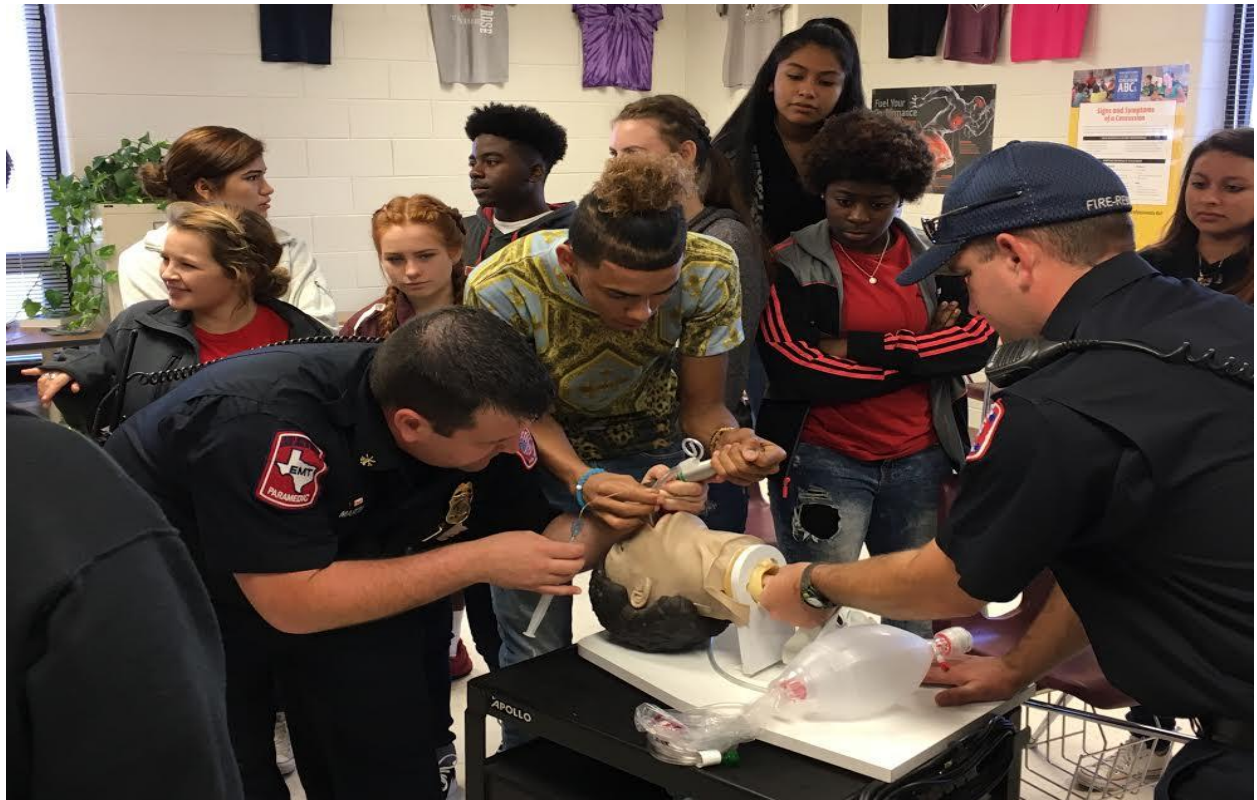
Hillsboro High School Board Report December 2016
