April 19	Elected board position candidates file declarations and completed applications with WESD no later than 5:00 p.m. on April 19 th . (Candidate Packet available at WESD and on WESD website).
April 26	Latest date for WESD to mail to each school district Board Chair & Superintendent (c/o School District Office) a ballot and candidate applications.
May 1-31	School district boards must cast their votes in a public meeting. Ballots must be received at the WESD no later than 5:00 p.m. on May 31 st .
June 4	Final date for WESD to count and tally votes for elected board positions.
June 7	Newly elected Board members are notified by WESD.
July 2	First Board Meeting - Directors Sworn In

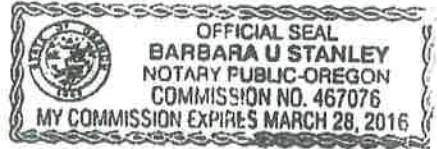
