- 4. Continued disproportionality in discipline and exclusion of children of color
- 5. Moving the work of Culturally Responsive Teaching practices, changing our academic results for children of color
- 6. Passing the May 17, 2011 \$63 million dollar Bond
- 7. Credit deficient 9th graders (one of the academic priority indicators)
- 8. Moving Credit Based on Proficiency forward as means of changing how student LEARN academic skills (as opposed to passing classes)
- 9. Advancement Via Individual Determination (AVID) framework K-12 by 2012
- 10. Dual Credit, Early College opportunities for all Parkrose School District students, access to Post Secondary Education/Training
