COMMENCEMENT EXERCISES

A student who has satisfactorily completed all coursework requirements for graduation but has failed to meet applicable state testing requirements shall be allowed to participate in commencement activities and ceremonies if the student satisfies the additional requirements set forth in this policy.

The additional requirements to receive a certificate of coursework completion at commencement shall be as follows:

- 1. The student shall have an overall attendance rate of at least 90 percent.
- 2. The student shall have at least a 90 percent attendance rate for all applicable state testing preparation classes.
- 3. The student shall have participated in all retake opportunities.
- 4. The student shall have regularly attended tutorial sessions scheduled by teachers.
- The student shall not have engaged in any serious misconduct violation of the Student Code of Conduct during his or her last two semesters.

For the purposes of this policy, serious misconduct shall be classified as behavior resulting in removal to a DAEP, suspension, or expulsion.
