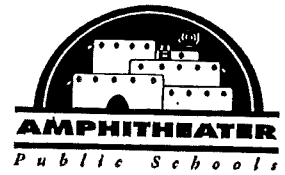

Brief description of project and how it is consistent with the Mission of SBCO (see SBCO Educational Enrichment Program Guidelines & Criteria)		The project would be to purchase a marimba and a vibraphone for Coronado's Band and Percussion Ensemble programs. The school has been able to purchase smaller instruments though the years; however, this is a major purchase. The marimba and vibraphone will expand the students' access to perform percussion literature and create both academic and extracurricular musical performance opportunities, while learning percussion instruments that are integral to the students' music education. This aligns with SBCO's mission to provide students with opportunities for success.

<p>From what schools or communities do the students come?</p>	<p>Coronado Middle School students live in the Catalina and Ranch Vistoso communities. Some students are open enrolled from San Manuel and Oracle.</p>
<p>How will students be recruited?</p>	<p>Students self-register into music classes. Students are encouraged to enroll in music classes in the spring prior to the new school year and receive information for all elective classes during open registration.</p>
<p>What criteria will be used in selecting students for the program?</p>	<p>All middle school music students who register and choose to perform in the percussion section of Coronado Middle School's two band ensembles, two percussion classes, or participate in the after-school indoor percussion ensemble will be eligible to perform on the marimba and vibraphone.</p>
<p>List your concrete and measurable student enrichment outcomes?</p>	<p>Students will learn basic technique, scales, arpeggios, musical phrasing, and percussion literature on the marimba and vibraphone. Students will be able to perform current band and percussion literature that often includes the marimba and vibraphone in the orchestration. Students will perform this music for their concerts, regional and state festivals, and at indoor percussion competitions.</p>
<p>What are your criteria for assessing each outcome?</p>	<p>The music teacher will assess each students' playing ability through observation. Festivals allow students to perform for adjudicators who rate/score performances and provide critique, while competitions will also include ranking the participating ensembles according to their overall performance. These assessments will help students grow in their musicianship and achieve greater success both individually and as an ensemble. Students will improve and succeed through guidance, collaboration, repetition, and performing with a goal of at least 90% accuracy.</p>

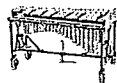
