

BACKGROUND



HOW PARTNERSHIP WORKS

SSAISD students enrolled at Pre-K 4 SA:

- Students are dually enrolled in District and Pre-K 4 SA
- District receives State funding
- Pre-K 4 SA bills district \$3,200 per child prorated for attendance
- District retains all additional funding including federal funds
- Pre-K 4 SA provides speech, language, OT, and PT services at no charge to the district

BENEFITS OF PARTNERSHIP

SSAISD is eligible for:

- Competitive grants
- Specialized professional learning plan
- Free Reading Academies for all K-3 teachers and leaders
- CDA path for staff and parents
- Recruiting events at Pre-K 4 SA
- Kinder transition plan



COMPETITIVE GRANT AWARDS

- Pre-K 4 SA Board of Directors voted on August 3, 2020 to approve a one-time grant award of \$250,000 to SSAISD for SY2020-21
- Pre-K 4 SA will utilize a needs assessment tool to identify Pre-K environment needs and professional learning
- SSAISD will work with Pre-K 4 SA to develop implementation plan
- SSAISD will be eligible to apply for the next Competitive Grant cycle in 2021-22

Individualized Professional Learning



- 20,000+ hours of free PL annually to PK-3rd grade educators in San Antonio
 - Seminars, workshops and coaching
 - Specialized training for parents to enter the ECE workforce
- Pre-K 4 SA PL Team will work with SSAISD to develop individualized Coaching Services for teachers and leaders that include customized support and on-site visits

READING ACADEMIES

- Pre-K 4 SA is an Authorized Provider for TEA HB3 Reading Academies
 - 3 cohort leaders
 - Offering Bi-literacy, Blended and Comprehensive models
- Pre-K 4 SA will provide TEA Reading
 Academy training for all South San
 Antonio ISD K-3 teachers and leaders at
 no cost to the district




CREDENTIALING AND OTHER SERVICES
