Key Actions: Prepare, Respond, Reunify

- Identified district reunification leader, backup, and team
- Identified personnel for specific roles for evacuation and reunification
- Provided Raptor access and mobile Raptor for those that require it
- Established district emergency incident protocols
- Conducted large-scale exercise to include reunification on July 30, 2024.
 - Additional training scheduled for Jan 6-7, 2025 and June 9-10, 2025
- Conducted training for administrative teams, campus staff, and district personnel before the start of the school year

Assess, Refine, and Accelerate

Rapid Response

Implemented a system which enables immediate activation of the reunification plan upon the occurrence of an emergency. Personnel identified for specific roles for evacuation and reunification

Clear Communication

Established effective communication channels to disseminate timely information to students, staff, parents, and the community.

Designated Reunification Sites

Identified and prepared secure and accessible reunification sites which accommodate a large number of people.

Trained Personnel

Ensured all school staff are adequately trained in emergency procedures, including reunification protocols.

Continuous Improvement

Regularly review and update the reunification plan based on lessons learned from drills, exercises, and actual emergencies.

Intentional Collaboration

Further foster collaboration with local law enforcement, emergency medical services, and other relevant agencies to ensure a coordinated response.


