# PROPOSED STUDENT OUTCOME GOALS, CONSTRAINTS, & PROGRESS MEASURES FOR 2018 AND BEYOND

Beginning with the 2019-2020 School Year, South San Antonio ISD will focus on the following Student Outcome Goals:

#### **Student Outcome Goal 1**

The percentage of graduating students who meet at least one College, Career, Military-Readiness (CCM-R) indicator will increase from 35% to 45% by August 2023.

The Superintendent shall not allow any campus to experience more than three consecutive years of an "F" rating designation.

The Superintendent shall take any actions necessary to improve campus academic performance.

# Constraint Progress Measure (CPM) 1.2:

The Superintendent will ensure quarterly common assessments are administered, data is disaggregated and reported in data meetings at the district and campus level.

# Constraint Progress Measure (CPM) 1.3:

The Superintendent will receive quarterly status reports (on track/off track) on the campus target improvement plans to meet accountability standards.

#### Superintendent Constraint 2

The Superintendent shall not reduce community wrap around services that would impact student outcomes based on locally funded programs in the 2018-2019 School Year.

#### Constraint Progress Measure (CPM) 2.1:

The Superintendent will ensure the following programs, Communities in Schools and Family Services, remain in active partnership in the 2019-2020

#### Constraint Progress Measure (CPM) 2.2:

The Superintendent shall not allow a reduction in the number of after school programs in elementary schools (SA Youth).

#### Constraint Progress Measure (CPM) 2.3:

The Superintendent shall develop three elementary schools (in each feeder pattern) as community hubs utilizing the Community Partner Program to provide access to food, cash and health care to qualifying participants.



#### Superintendent Constraint 3

The Superintendent will not allow a reduction of general education student transportation services that would impact student attendance rates based on the 2018-2019 School Year.

#### Constraint Progress Measure (CPM) 3.1:

The Superintendent will not approve less than the set number of routes based on the 2018-2019 School Year.

#### Constraint Progress Measure (CPM) 3.2:

The Superintendent will implement a transportation marketing plan for the 2019-2020 School Year.

## Constraint Progress Measure (CPM) 3.3:

The Superintendent will not allow less student ridership based on the 2018-2019 School Year.

Beginning with the 2019-2020 School Year, South San Antonio ISD will focus on the following Board Constraints:

#### **Board Constraint 1**

 The Board collectively, and trustees individually, shall not perform or appear to perform any of the roles delegated to the Superintendent.

#### **Board Constraint 2**

 The Board shall not allow the introduction of new information or materials related to agenda items once the agenda is posted.

#### **Board Constraint 3**

 The Board's discussion of any non-student outcome goal agenda item shall not exceed 21 minutes with each trustee allowed three minutes to comment.
