-Parent/Teacher Conference Recap: Parent/Teacher Conferences were held on Thursday, October 5th from 12-8pm. We held a conference for 94% of our students at Lincoln School. We received very positive feedback from parents on their conversations with their child's teacher. From our survey results, it was clear that parents love the usage of ClassDojo and found the conferences to be helpful.

-Lincoln School Report Card:

### Positives:

- Chronic Absences down to 13.9% in 2023 from 28.2% in 2022
- Student Attendance up to 94.2% in 2023 up from 92% in 2022
- Teacher Attendance 84.3% missed less than 10 days

### Future Areas of Focus:

- Raising Math Growth Score
  - More spiraling of curriculum (Fridays, homework, morning work, etc)
  - Exposure to IAR test level math word problems
  - Investigating a new math series

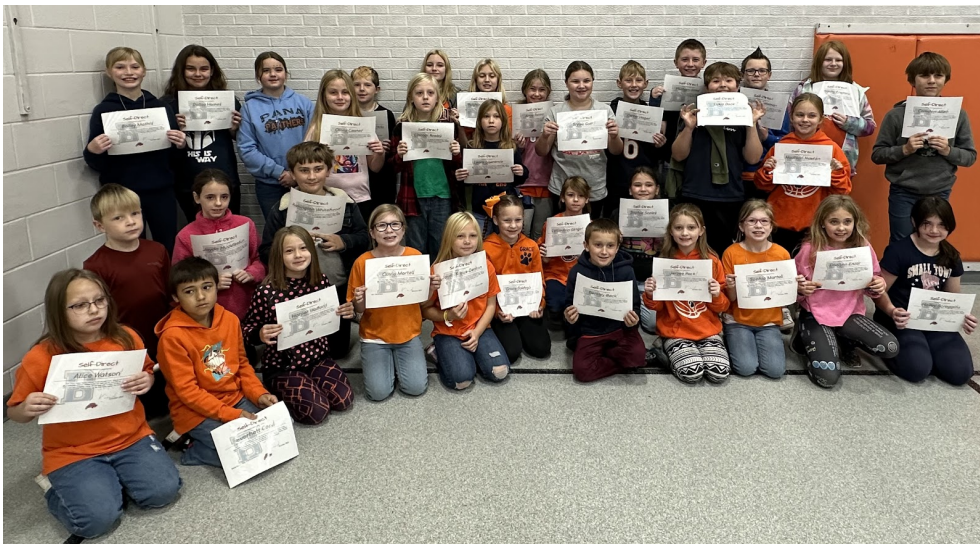

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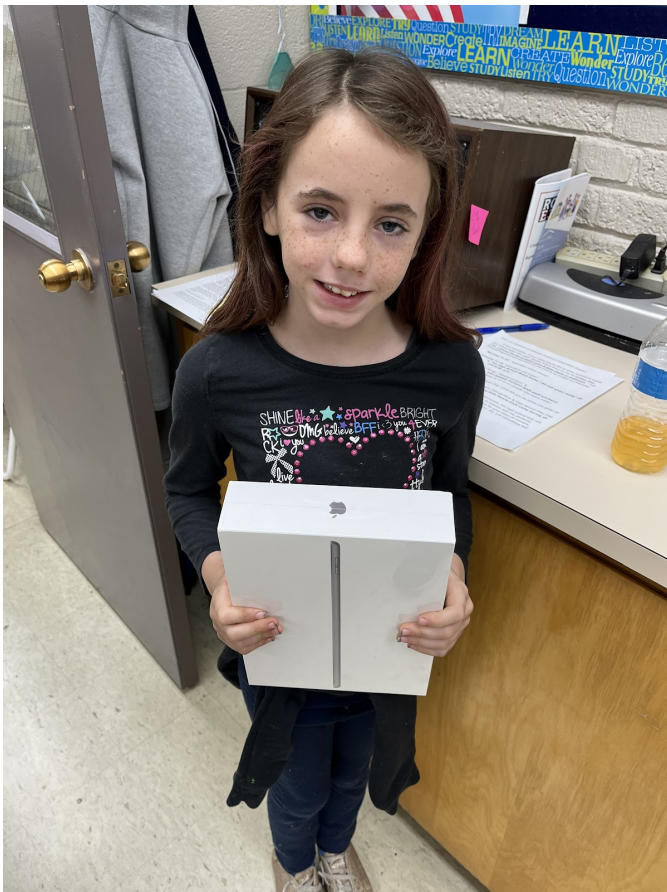




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
