

Governor Signs Budget and Marshall Plan

Last week, Gov. Rick Snyder <u>signed Senate Bill 848</u>, which contained the budgets for all of the state departments. He signed the entire bill without any line-item vetoes. On Tuesday, he signed <u>SBs 941-942</u>, which contain the Marshall Plan. Then yesterday, he signed <u>House Bill 5579</u>, which included the budgets for School Aid, Community Colleges and Universities. Again, he approved the budgets without making any vetoes.
