TEACHER SALARY SCHEDULE Hourly rate of 24.00 per hour

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Summer school courses require a minimum enrollment of ten students for the class to be taught.
- The operation of the summer school program will comply with public school accountability and accreditation standards, and will be self-supporting in terms of teacher salaries.
- The instructional program will provide students the opportunity to repeat a course failed. Acceleration classes in Algebra I, Biology I, US History and English II will not be offered during the summer term.
- Students will comply with the policies of the TPSD and the THS Student Handbook. Students will attend an orientation assembly on **Tuesday, June 3, 2008**, at 7:45 AM.
- No refund will be extended after **Friday, June 6, 2008**.
- To receive credit for make-up work upon the second absence, a student may contract with his/her teacher at \$10.00 per hour to complete make-up work. All make-up work must be completed at times other than during the regular (7:45 AM – 3:45 PM) summer school hours. Administrative approval is required.

- Serious discipline matters that routinely are forwarded to an assistant principal or district hearing committee will result in removal of the student from summer school program. No refund will be extended to the student or parent.

Resident students are defined as those students whose legal place of residence, as determined by the place of residence of their parents or legal guardians, falls within the boundaries of the TPSD. Additionally, for purposes of determining summer school tuition and summer school enrollment only, students who have been properly released to and enrolled in the TPSD during the 2007-2008 school year as “tuition” students will be considered “resident” students and will pay the resident rate for summer school tuition.
