AGENDA ITEM: Consider Approval of Aledo ISD 2019 Legislative Priorities

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

At the August 20th, 2018 regular Board meeting, the Board of Trustees created the Board Legislative Committee. The committee provides reports about laws, policies, and activities by our state and federal lawmakers that may impact Aledo ISD. The committee has also worked to construct Aledo ISD's legislative priorities, and will lead the Board in identifying and participating in opportunities for Board members to advocate for the needs of AISD's students, staff, and community. This work is especially important now, since the 86th Texas Legislative Session is upcoming, convening in January 2019.

At the November 12th, 2018 regular Board meeting, the Board of Trustees discussed a rough draft of the legislative priorities. Since then, the document has been revised and refined, based on the discussion at the November meeting and the work of the Legislative Committee.

The Legislative Committee and the Administration are recommending that the Board approve the Aledo ISD 2019 Legislative Priorities as presented so that the document can guide the work of the district as we share the needs of our students and staff with our community and lawmakers.
