

# Field Biology Class




Ms. Waggaman will be teaching Field Biology after school. The focus of this class is to work on the Tom Kulbartz Nature Area behind GRHS.

Classes will be held every Tues/Thurs during the fall and spring. Some classes may be held during the winter. Students can earn a 1/2 Science credit for participating in this class!










