Recommendation:

Seek competitive sealed bids for the purchase of simulation manikins, defibrillators, and an interactive video training system for use in training our EMS students.

Background and Rationale:

The College's EMS Program received a Texas Reskilling & Upskilling for Education (TRUE) Grant to assist Colleges and their students needing new or additional skills training in order to reenter the workforce. The grant will provide equipment for schools, and scholarships to students seeking an EMS Certification. Some of the equipment that is needed will require the College to seek competitive bids. The items listed above will all require either competitive bids or purchases using a recognized cooperative contract to comply with the grant rules.
