### **Background Information**

A diverse Calendar Planning Committee, composed of teachers, parents, community members, students, campus and district administrators, directors, and coordinators, collaboratively identified the district’s priority considerations for the 2026–2027 academic calendar. The committee reviewed instructional needs, state requirements, student and staff well-being, and operational factors to ensure that proposed calendar options would best support teaching and learning across the district.

Based on the committee’s guidance, multiple calendar options were developed and shared with staff, parents, and students through a districtwide survey to gather broad stakeholder input. The survey was made widely accessible via the district website, direct email communication to staff and families, and the district’s social media platforms to encourage strong community participation. The survey results, along with the committee’s recommendations and analysis, are being presented to the Board of Trustees to inform their deliberations and final approval of the 2026–2027 academic calendar.

### **Recommendation**

The Duncanville Independent School District’s Board of Trustees approve the Academic Calendar Option A for the 2026-2027 school year.
