SUBJECT: **PARENT-TEACHER ADVISORY COMMITTEE DISCUSSION**

The Parent-Teacher Advisory Committee convened on February 9, 2026, to address several key areas, including current discipline policies, procedures, the Student Information Handbook, and the proposed school calendar for the upcoming year. Additionally, the committee incorporated the responsibilities of the Behavioral Interventions Committee, as outlined in Board Policy 7030, *Board Committees*, and reviewed the District's process for behavioral interventions.

Although the Parent-Teacher Advisory Committee and the Behavioral Interventions Committee have no official recommendations for changes for the 2026-2027 School Year, valuable feedback was shared by both parents and student participants. Comments focused on the District's effectiveness in areas such as relationship building, Social-Emotional Learning (SEL)/mental health support, and proactive anti-bullying programs.

Specific praise was offered by an elementary parent and the two student representatives from Jefferson. They expressed being impressed and grateful for the District, with the parent highlighting a strong sense of safety for their child(ren) and a positive experience, particularly at Jefferson. Furthermore, multiple parents commended the talent of our teachers and the special environment they create for students. These positive comments will be shared with the administrative team.

The only suggestion raised by a committee member pertained to the next year's calendar, and this has been addressed in the Action Item Calendar memo.
