Unity School District - Board of Education Board Policy 447.2 Outside of the School Day Detention Last Revised 2/14/2023

The Superintendent may authorize the high school principal to implement a detention for students outside the school day to serve as a student discipline program to deter unexcused absences, excessive tardiness and persistent violation of district rules/regulations.

The detention program details are to be approved by the Superintendent.

The Unity School District shall not discriminate in standards and rules of behavior or disciplinary measures, including suspensions and expulsions, on the basis of sex, race, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
