1:1 Laptops



- Laptops distribution numbers remain about the same. iPads, additional laptops available
 for student use The students are using the laptops in classes every day, and repairs are
 handled quickly.
- Laptop repairs continue on a regular basis by the IT & DHS LMC staff. Purchasing replacement parts at lowest possible cost in bulk (LCD screen, plastic base parts, hard drives).
- IT/LMC Staff see average of 30 repair issues per week at DHS and 40 at DMS.
- Computers remain up-to-date for all software through our district computer update servers and set up to be more efficient and easier for student use.
- Laptops have been updated with the latest version of the Smarter Balanced Web Browser and are ready to be used for testing time.
- Students encouraged to use Google Apps as much as possible for their work.

Ongoing Work and Projects



- Prepared the district technology for state testing. IT provide support during all testing
- Reviewed and proposed BOE Technology Policies:
 Acceptable Use Policy & Cell Phone Policy
- Planing to purchase and implement a new internet filter to align with state's CEN network.
- Completed PC & software installation of Softplan Architectural Software for DHS Tech Ed.
- Performing updates, software installation, security updates as needed on all district computers.
- Working with Irving & Bradley Principals to purchase and implement keyboarding software and a keyboarding curriculum. Looking at cloud/web based solutions.
- Eno board installations, Projector installations and repairs continue throughout the district. Using available funding to provide new installations at Bradley & Irving

Ongoing Work and Projects



- Continue to support, maintain, repair and oversee use of student laptops.
- Continue to address staff technology issues and answer helpdesk requests as quickly as possible. We continue to work on decreasing response time.
- Television for Digital Signage installed and operating in DHS LMC.
- Provided Training to BOE and Bradley Staff in Google Apps for Education, more training to come
- Continue to update the Technology section of the district website to provide up-to-date information about the 1:1 initiative, Technology goals and resources, etc. for staff, students, BOE, and the public.

- Speakers selected for Irving Cafeteria and order will be placed when funding available.


