(HB3 Required Goal) Goal 3*: The percentage of graduates that meet the criteria for CCMR will increase from 72% to 88% by August 2024 and increase to 95% by 2028. (HB3 Required Goal) D. **Summary:** Learning Acceleration Support Opportunities (LASO) is a single, consolidated application that combines grants, allotments, and in-kind supports, bundled around a few key strategies to accelerate academic gains. LASO Cycle 4 will offer 15 opportunities focused on curriculum & instruction, educator training, more time, and innovative school models. In total, this cycle has 500 million in funds available across various initiatives and many of the LASO grants in this cycle are multi-year with continuation grant opportunities.

Background Information:

This is the fourth cycle of the Learning Acceleration Support Opportunities (LASO) grant. NISD has received grant funds for Cycle 1, 2 and now 3. These funds have allowed us to fully implement high-quality instructional materials for RLA K-8 and Mathematics K- Algebra I. They have also provided us with funds to sustain two full-time instructional coaches. The Cycle 4 grant opportunity will provide us with the following opportunities if we apply:

- (1) Leadership & Instructional Foundations for Texas (LIFT) 3 year program to build instructional capacity around the state Bluebonnet curriculum including training and skill building, coaching cycles and supports from an approved service provider
- (2) Blended Learning Grant (BLG) 3 year program This award will provide us with software licenses for IXL and Amira. The funds can be used to off-set the district expenses (currently more than 40,000 and provide professional development training
- (3) Advanced Placement Computer Science Principles (APCSP) 1 year program. As our CTE program expands, we are looking at adding an additional CTE teacher that can fully implement a Computer Science Pathway, separate from the P-TECH program. This award would allow the district to provide professional learning for an AP Computer Science teacher, pay for the AP test costs for students, and purchase supplies and materials needed for the APCSP course
- (4) PREP Program Allotment: PREP Residency Preservice Program 1 year program. This is an allotment program and our district will automatically receive the funds if we apply. This grant provides funding for teacher residents to work in classrooms with experienced teachers while earning teaching certificates. It will help Navarro ISD to cultivate a pipeline of well-prepared, high qualified teachers.
- (5) PREP Program Allotment: PREP Grown Your Own (GYO)
 Program This allotment would support current employees in
 completing a bachelor's degree and teacher preparation while
 employed. It also supports high school students who want to
 complete CTE courses that prepare them for teaching careers (our
 current Teaching and Training pathway).
- (6) PREP Program Allotment: PREP Mentorship Program This is another allotment program and if the district applies, we would automatically receive funds to increase teacher effectiveness and retention by providing strong mentorship. The funds can be used to provide mentor stipends, provide mentorship training or provide mentoring release time (pay for subs, etc.).
- (7) Texas Strategic Staffing for Residencies (TSS) Grants This is a two-year award which will provide funding for a staff member to
