- The 4 year old classrooms have completed theme 8 "Let's Explore". They learned about science tools & their uses & how we can find science inside & outside. They expanded the unit to include various countries such as: Mexico, Italy, China, & the US.
- The 3 year old classrooms have been learning about Community Helpers, Multicultural, & Music. Learning that community helpers are here to help, discussing what they want to be when they grow up, how everyone is different, different types of food, & listened to various music & had a chance to experiment with different musical instruments.
