# April 2026 Report

## Diagnosticians

We have received over 37 referrals to date at the elementary. All annual ARDS have been completed and initial and re-evaluations are currently being worked on. Italy is also in our cyclical monitoring. We will have our report by the end of July. We have worked with Stafford to set up a training at the beginning of the year for MTSS and behavior for all general education staff to help support students prior to the special education process. Working on ESY prep and finishing up end of year ARDS for initial referrals - several ARDS have been moved up so students can start out in their new placement.

## Updates:

### NCEC -

7 students-6 boys and 1 girl.

We are implementing the STAR curriculum as well.

One new student is in the evaluation process.

Gathering data for ESY considerations.

Next year we will start the year with 3 students in the room - but a possibility of several more added by Thanksgiving depending on evaluation data.

**Elementary FLS (functional life skills) :** 10 students. Currently working on implementing the STAR program with the students. Gathering data for ESY.

Next year the class will start with 9 students.

**Elementary FLA (functional life academics):** 8 students. Working on implementing the STAR program with the students. Gathering data for ESY.

Next year the class will start with 10 students. Planning on several going to out classes during the day as the students can handle it.

**Elementary SET:** At this time I am teaching 4 SET classes. I am working with 6 students on this campus and do check in's for two in Milford. I am also assisting with the FLA class.

We are starting to see some behaviors amp up - typical with it being towards the end of the year.

Starting the year teaching small group social skills. Depending on new students - we are hoping we can keep the groups small so we can hone in on individual skills.

**Secondary FLS (Functional life skills):** 4 high needs students. We are working to include our new secondary STAR curriculum. We went on an outing to the store. We will be doing those more often. We had prom and one of our students attended and had a good time. Gathering ESY data.

Depending on start-up we will have 3 at the beginning of the year.

**Secondary FLA (functional life academics):** 12 students. Many of the students are in and out during the day. Several have resource and some general education classes. Gathering data for ESY.

We will start the year off with 9 students - several of which will go out to various out classes during the day.

**Secondary SET:** Currently serving 21 students on caseload with BIP's. Have 9 students receiving social skills at the secondary level.

Starting to see some uptick of behaviors - common towards the end of the year. We are supporting staff and students.

Level Up Cafe is going great. Cafe is open daily and in the afternoons, the students are working on other job related skills. On Monday's and Wednesday's - the students are going to Central Baptist Church and First Baptist Church to clean the sanctuary from Sunday's service and get ready for the weeks events. Wednesday's - they make and deliver breakfast to both Stafford and the HS and on Thursday they do the same with lunch. Tuesday afternoons is their shopping day to get ready for the week.

Next year we will have 2 different groups in our 18+ program. We will have 3 working in our Cafe full time and we will have 2 in another group focusing on life skills and independent living

skills. We are super excited to be graduating 5 from one of our 2 self contained high school classes and they are all eligible to come back to continue working on their job skills.

All of our classes and various departments are already working on things for next year. We have had a fantastic school year and we are all looking forward to some exciting things to come.
