**SUBJECT:** Board Policy 4:10 Revisions

## PROPOSED ACTION:

That the Dunlap Board of Education approved the proposed edits to Board Policy 4:10 as presented.

## **BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

Board Policy 4:10 focuses on fiscal and business management for the district. The policy outlines the budget process—from planning to formal adoption and any potential amendments. The proposed additions to policy 4:10 outline the annual review and approval of any assessed fees as they relate to:

- School registration,
- Textbook use/rental fees,
- Technology fees,
- Specific course fees,

- Specific equipment fees,
- Extracurricular/co-curricular activities fees, and
- Other fees approved by the Board of Education.

The policy outlines the process to collect fees, including making families aware of the fee waiver process (Board Policy 4:140), entering into a payment plan, and a proposed process to collect uncollected fees. As of Friday, November 7, 2025, the district has a total of \$142,722.27 in uncollected student fees. Below, you will find a table breakdown for each building.

Dunlap High School's total is considerably higher not only because there are more fees assessed at the high-school level, but also because unpaid fees accrue each year and follow from building to building.
