

TITLE: Consider Mid-Contract Termination of Probationary Contract

DATE: November 18, 2025

BACKGROUND:

As you recall, on October 29, 2025 Dr. Cantu gave the Board notice of intent to terminate the probationary contract of a teacher. This was the result of allegations of serious misconduct, placement on administrative leave, and a subsequent felony arrest. The teacher received the notice of intent to terminate his probationary contract and had 15 days from receipt of the notice to request a hearing. The teacher did not request a hearing. Therefore, the Board may now terminate his probationary contract, effective immediately, for good cause.

CONSIDERATIONS:

- Approve terminating the 2025 2026 probationary contract of a teacher, effective immediately.
- Do not approve the mid-contract termination of the teacher's 2025 2026 probationary contract, which will result in the teacher continuing to have a probationary contract for the remainder of this school year.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Superintendent recommends mid-contract termination of the teacher's probationary contract.

If Board agrees, the motion would be:

"I move that the Board terminate the 2025 - 2026 probationary teacher contract of the named teacher for good cause, effective immediately, and authorize the Superintendent of Schools to send the notice letter."
