**TOPIC: Purchase of HMH Into Reading Materials for Upper Elementary Schools**

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District approve the purchase of 6-year licenses for HMH *Into Reading* and teacher and support materials for our Upper Elementary Schools at a cost of \$276,536.36, including shipping and handling with \$176,496.87 in free materials, including teacher resources, licenses and professional development.

**RATIONALE:**

The textbook was evaluated using the district textbook adoption process and the upper elementary school principals support the recommendation. The recommendation has been reviewed and supported by the Curriculum Committee.

**BUDGETARY INFORMATION:**

The purchase of *Into Reading* 2020 (HMH) will be charged to the District's Elementary Textbook budget, which has been supported by the Wayne County Enhancement Mileage.
