Re: Course Revision— Probability & Statistics: Transitional Math QL/Stats

I respectfully recommend revising the current Probability & Statistics course to JJC's Transitional Math QL/Stats for the 2026-2027 school year. This 1-credit, unweighted elective would be offered as a year-long course for 12th-grade students, serving as a vital college-preparatory pathway.

This course is specifically engineered to transition students into college-level pathways requiring Quantitative Literacy and Statistics. By earning a "C" or higher (70%+) in both semesters, students receive statewide portability on their JTHS transcript. This guarantees automatic placement into the following credit-bearing courses at JJC (and all Illinois community colleges):

- Math for Technical Students (Math 119)
- Math for General Education (Math 127)
- Elementary Statistics (Math 128)

This transition removes the need for high-stakes math placement exams and protects students from being placed into non-credit remedial courses. Furthermore, it provides a clear solution for students who may have struggled in previous courses; for example, students who earned below a "C" in Geometry currently risk additional testing requirements that this transitional course bypasses.

This course addition has been reviewed and approved by the Curriculum Coordinating Council.
