SUGGESTED SCHOOL BOARD ACTION: Report only

DESCRIPTION:

This summer, Community Education (CE) will again offer referral-only remedial reading and math classes using Targeted Services funding. These classes are taught by BHM District teachers and are free of charge to in-district children. This year, 567 students were referred for reading and/or math or the Tier 3 Intervention Program.

Students who are referred for Targeted Services may also choose classes in the Sun Block program and use our centralized transportation from each of the District elementary schools.

KidKare students will also participate in the Sun Block program as part of their day and will choose from a wide variety of enrichment classes offered.

The Targeted Services and Sun Block program will be located at Buffalo Community Middle School (BCMS) this year. The program will be offered Monday-Thursday, 8:30-11:30 from June 19-July 27. This will be 12 hours less of instruction than what has been offered in the past in order to accommodate the cleaning schedule across the District.

Students attending CE summer programs can have breakfast and lunch at no cost by taking advantage of the USDA Summer Food Program.

In addition to the Sun Block program, CE continues to offer activities and events for children and adults in the BHM communities. Below is a list of several examples of the opportunities CE will provide this the summer:

- ECFE- concerts in the Park and classes
- Early Childhood Screening
- Family Literacy/GED classes
- KidKare/Little KidKare
- Youth Recreation camps - tennis, football, basketball, volleyball, gymnastics
- Youth Enrichment afternoon classes - STEM, Robotics, theater, Kinder Music, Arts
- SPARK - Montrose
- Swim lessons – BCMS pool and Pulaski Beach
- Robotics camps - Elementary/Middle School
- Mock Trail

- Tutoring
- High School Driver Education - locations at HES, MES and BHS
- Adult Enrichment - trips to Minnesota State Capital, Paddle Ford River Cruise, State Fair
- Adults with Disabilities - trips, picnics, BBQ, and Fishing with Forever Fishing
