Spanish at North Valley High School

North Valley students have the opportunity to take up to four trimesters of Spanish. Students who plan on attending an Oregon university must demonstrate proficiency in a second language by completing two years of the same language in high school with a grade of C- or better, or P (pass).

For Three Rivers students this means that your child must complete four trimesters of Spanish: Spanish 1A, Spanish 1B, Spanish 2A and Spanish 2B. As you plan your schedules for next year, please consider Spanish. Remember, it only gets harder to fit into your schedule!
