Smiles across Montana

SAM's purpose is to make sure children have a positive dental experience, especially those who do not have dental coverage due to lack of dental insurance or any other reason. The founders of SAM feel there is no reason children can't be seen in a comfortable and safe environment, while allowing parents the opportunity not to miss work while providing their children preventive dental care.

Here are the numbers from their February visit to our BMS campus:

Total number of students seen: 30.

Total number of referrals: 10.

Total number of services provided (this includes cleaning, fluoride, silver diamine fluoride, exams (teledental), x-rays, intra-oral images, sealants and sealant repairs, tobacco cessation, oral hygiene instruction, and nutritional counseling): **346 total teeth serviced!!**



DESSA

Browning Middle School began it's DESSA winter screening of students on February 7th to February 18th. The Devereux Student Strengths Assessment (DESSA) assesses eight social and emotional competencies and is intended to help educators plan instruction, document

students' strengths and areas of need, inform progress monitoring, and evaluate program outcomes and it is applicable grade levels K-8.

Along with the DESSA and DESSA-mini (a shorter, but still reliable 8-question screener), DESSA System users have access to research-informed Intervention Strategies and Foundational Practices, used to bolster social and emotional skills on eight SEL competencies. These strategies can be used universally (large group settings, like a classroom), in small groups, individually, or as take-home assignments. In addition, each competency comes with a teacher reflection activity – allowing users to understand their own social and emotional strengths and areas of need.



Family Literacy Night

Our social studies teachers held their Family Literacy Night on Thursday, February 17, 2022. A total of 18 parents attended the drive-through format at BMS, and a total of 12 food boxes were given to the families. In addition to the food packages, hygiene packages, winter coats and shoes were also distributed to the families that were in need of those items. With the assistance of Ms. Joey Hall, the event was a great success. Our next FLN will be March 10th, where our AVID teachers will take the spotlight.
