- ✓ Local school boards must approve the CDP, but approval is **not required annually** if there are no significant changes. While there have been no major updates, we felt it important to share the plan with the board.
- ✓ In Illinois, the CDP is an annual document that outlines how districts use federal grants and other funding to meet student needs, consolidating multiple grant applications into one plan.
