Consolidated Plan

The district's submission of the Consolidated Federal and State Grant Application (CFSGA) is due August 31. This application outlines our planned use of federal and state dollars for the coming year. A large portion of each program is dedicated to staffing classified and certified staff within the three buildings. Our preliminary awards have been adjusted slightly over the last month.

Our preliminary grant awards:

Title I-A, Improving Basic Programs - \$293,328

Title I-C, Education of Migratory Children- \$75,848

Title II-A, Supporting Effective Instruction - \$52,611

Title III-A, English Language Acquisition - \$13,104

State English Learner Program - \$23,983

Title IV-A Student Support and Academic Enrichment- \$10,000

Title V-B Rural Education Program- \$20,690

Final figures are typically available in October.
